Valley Express Bus & Dial-A-Ride connects people of all ages & abilities to our community & promotes independence & prosperity through a safe & convenient public transit system.

Valley Express operates Fixed Route bus service and general public Dial-A-Ride. Fixed route service travels along a set route according to the schedule. Dial-A-Ride is curb-to-curb (origin to destination) service available to the general public and ADA complementary paratransit certified riders.

WELCOME ABOARD

To ensure everyone's experience on our buses is pleasant, please observe the following guidelines.

- › Smoking is not permitted on-board or within 25 feet of any bus stop or bus shelter
- › Headphones must be used for audio devices, phones, tablets, etc.
- › Minimize conversations with the drivers
- › Hold small children securely
- › Anything brought on-board must remain in your possession and out of aisles at all times
- › Non-service animals may be transported on the bus only in a carrier/crate and cannot block aisles or take up seating
- › Damages caused by a service animal or pet are the responsibility of the owner

The following are never permitted on buses.

- › Open food and beverage containers
- › Personal belongings that may block aisles or take up seats
- › Items too numerous to be controlled, carried, or handled by a passenger
- › Firearms, weapons, or hazardous materials

UNACCOMPANIED MINORS

Parents should use their judgment when letting children ride the bus unaccompanied. Children five years and under are not permitted to ride the bus without an accompanying caregiver over 12 years of age.

Please have exact fare ready in the form of cash, pass, or transfer.

- › Reduced fares are available on **Fixed Route** buses for riders age 65 and older, people with disabilities and Medicare cardholders
- › Children under the age of 5 years ride free when accompanied by a fare-paying passenger
- › 31-Day Full and Reduced Fare Fixed Route passes are valid on fixed-route buses for 31 days from the date first used
- › 31-Day Full and Reduced Super Passes are valid on fixed-route and/or Dial-A-Ride buses for 31 days from the date first used

TRANSFERS

- › Request Transfer upon boarding **ONLY**
- › Transfers using VCbuspass occur automatically, no paper transfer will be given
- › There is no charge to transfer between Valley Express fixed route buses and VCTC Intercity buses
- › There is a \$0.50 charge to transfer from VCTC Intercity and Valley Express fixed route to Dial-A-Ride service
- › Transfers are good for a limited period of time
- › Transfers that are expired or not properly validated will not be honored

YOUTH RIDE FREE PROMOTIONAL PROGRAM

Free bus service is available on all local buses to anyone 18 years or younger. Drivers will let anyone who looks 18 or younger board the bus but high school-aged students should be prepared to show ID. goventura.org/youth

COLLEGE RIDE PILOT PROGRAM

Free bus service is available on all local buses for students of all Ventura County Adult Schools, Cal Lutheran University, CSUCI, Moorpark College, Ventura College, Oxnard College, UCSB, and SBCC. CSUCI students must tap their student ID. Students from all other colleges, as well as CSUCI staff, must show their ID to board.



VCBUSPASS

The VCbuspass is a new contactless regional transit pass for Ventura County. Stored value (pay as you go) and 31-day regional passes are available. Purchase a reloadable card online or from one of our sales locations or download the Umo mobility app on your phone. Passes that are for use on Valley Express buses only are not available on the VCbuspass app or card.

HOW TO RIDE

- › Please make sure that you are at the Valley Express bus stop or scheduled pickup location
- › Wait for the bus to come to a complete stop and for any passengers to exit before boarding
- › Pay your fare as you board using cash, your pass, and/or show appropriate ID
- › If you have questions about stops or need a transfer, ask the driver when you board
- › As a courtesy, please leave the front seats open for seniors and people with disabilities
- › All buses are ADA accessible and equipped with a lift or ramp; passengers may request to use the lift or ramp regardless of mobility device
- › You may request that the driver alert you when you are approaching your stop
- › Listen for stop announcements while riding so that you will be aware when the bus is approaching your stop

HOW TO EXIT

- › For Fixed Route, before you arrive at your stop, pull the gray wire (or stop request button) to alert the driver that you wish to exit
- › Remain seated until the bus has come to a complete stop and then exit
- › For your safety, wait until the bus pulls away before crossing the street
- › Never cross in front of a bus

PASSENGER CODE OF CONDUCT

Valley Express will not provide service to passengers that engage in any behavior listed below. Violators may be subject to suspension of riding privileges, citation, or arrest.

- › Threats of harm, assault, or battery on a driver or passenger
- › Harassment, verbal abuse, or intimidation of and/or altercation with any Valley Express customers, riders, or personnel
- › Smoking on any Valley Express vehicles; this includes e-cigarettes
- › Drug and/or alcohol use on Valley Express vehicles
- › Any type of radio/electronic device or noise making device (including a cellphone) without the use of a headset
- › Operating any of the vehicle's controls
- › Failure to obey a driver's lawful instructions
- › Damage or vandalism of any Valley Express vehicles
- › Repeated violations of Rider Guidelines
- › Criminal conduct prohibited by the California Penal Code

WHAT IS DIAL-A-RIDE SERVICE?

Dial-A-Ride is a shared-ride bus service that takes passengers from curb-to-curb (origin to destination) (*some exceptions apply*).

Dial-A-Ride for the General Public

- › Is available to EVERYONE
- › Is scheduled on the same day
- › Is provided on a space available basis
- › Seniors 65 years and older may call up to seven days in advance to reserve their ride

Dial-A-Ride for ADA Paratransit Riders

- › ADA Paratransit Riders are given priority when using Dial-A-Ride service
- › Reservations may be scheduled up to a week in advance
- › Same day reservations are exempt from ADA Paratransit regulations

ADA Paratransit Time Negotiation

ADA Paratransit trips are guaranteed when reserved at least one day in advance. To guarantee trip availability, pickup times may be 'negotiated' up to one hour before or after the originally requested pickup time.

Subscriptions or Standing Reservations

Subscription trips happen at the same time, on the same days, repeatedly; such as to and from work, medical treatment, or school. Subscription Service is provided on a first-come first-served basis and is limited. Only half of the trips during any given hour may be subscription based.

WHERE CAN I RIDE?

General Public Dial-A-Ride service is available within Fillmore, Santa Paula, Piru, and other unincorporated areas of the Heritage Valley. Seniors and ADA certified riders may use Dial-A-Ride to travel between Fillmore, Santa Paula, and Saticoy. The Valley Express-GCTD GO Access transfer point is at Wells Road in Saticoy.

HOW DO I RESERVE A RIDE?

General Public Trips:

Please call at least two hours before your desired trip time. Reservations between 6:00 am and 8:30 am may be called in the day before.

Seniors and ADA Paratransit Trips:

Please call no less than one day in advance.

PICK-UP WINDOW

Valley Express Dial-A-Ride buses may arrive up to 30 minutes AFTER your scheduled pick-up time. Please be ready.

All buses are ADA accessible and equipped with a lift or ramp to accommodate wheelchairs and personal mobility devices. You may also request that the driver alert you when you are approaching your stop.

ADA ELIGIBILITY & CERTIFICATION INFORMATION

ADA certification allows you to use all complimentary paratransit services in every city in Ventura County and receive priority booking on the Valley Express Dial-A-Ride. You must first complete an application for ADA certification. The application requires an explanation as to why you are unable to use the regular public bus service.
